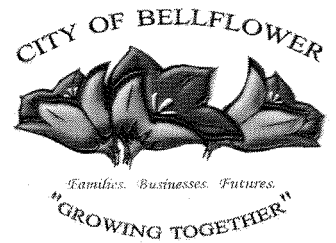




Citizen's Guide To Electrical Permit Fees



BUILDING & SAFETY DIVISION

Issuance of each electrical permit	\$24.50
Issuance of each supplemental permit for which the original permit has not expired, been canceled, or finalized:	\$7.50

New Residential

New single-family dwelling or duplex not including garages, carports, and other minor accessory buildings**:	\$0.058/sq. ft.
New three or more unit multi-family dwellings not including garages, carports, and other non-residential areas:	\$0.052/sq.ft.

****NOTE:** For attached garages constructed at the same time as single or two-family residential buildings, a separate fee will not be required if the square footage value used to determine the electrical permit fee includes the garage.

Unit Fee Schedule (alternate to branch circuit fees)

Receptacle, switch, and light outlet boxes	
First 20 outlet boxes:	\$1.15 Ea.
Additional outlet boxes after 20:	\$0.75 Ea.
Light fixtures	
First 20 fixtures:	\$1.15 Ea.
Additional fixtures after 20:	\$0.75 Ea.
Pole or platform-mounted lighting fixtures:	\$1.15 Ea.
Theatrical-type lighting fixtures or assemblies:	\$1.15 Ea.

NOTE: For multi-outlet assemblies, each 5' or fraction thereof may be considered as one outlet.

Branch circuit fees (alternate to unit fees)

Based on the number of branch circuits proposed.	
1 to 10 branch circuits inclusive:	\$11.00 Ea.
11 to 40 branch circuits inclusive:	\$9.00 Ea.
41 or more branch circuits:	\$8.25 Ea.
15 or 20 ampere 208 volt to 277 volt lighting circuits:	\$17.25 Ea.

Electrical Permit Fees

Appliances

Residential Appliances of 3 HP or less:	\$4.90 Ea.
Nonresidential Appliances of 3 HP or less:	\$4.90 Ea.

Notes:

1) **Residential appliances** include wall-mounted electric ovens; counter-mounted cooking tops; electric ranges; self-contained room, console or through-the-wall air conditioners; space heaters; food waste grinders; dishwashers; washing machines; water heaters; clothes dryers; or other motor-driven appliances having larger electrical ratings, see Power Apparatus.

2) **Nonresidential appliances** includes medical and dental devices; foot beverage and ice cream cabinets; illuminated show cases; drinking fountains; vending machines; laundry machines; or other similar types of equipment not exceeding 3HP in rating. For other types of motor-driven appliances having larger electrical ratings, see Power Apparatus.

Power Apparatus

Rating in HP, kW, kVA, or kVAR	
Over 3 but not over 10:	\$12.74 Ea.
Over 10 but not over 50:	\$25.50 Ea.
Over 50 but not over 100:	\$51.25 Ea.
Over 100:	\$77.00 Ea.

Notes:

- 1) For equipment or appliances having more than one motor, transformer, heater, etc., the sum of the combined ratings may be used.
- 2) These fees include all switches, circuit breakers, contractors, thermostats, relays and other directly related control equipment.

Signs, Outline Lighting and Marquees

For signs, outline lighting systems or marquees supplied from one branch circuit:	\$25.50 Ea.
Additional branch circuits supplying the same sign, Outline lighting system or marquee.	\$12.75 Ea.

Services

Service of 600 volts or less and not over 399 amperes In rating:	\$25.50 Ea.
Services of 600 volts or less and 400 to 1,000 amperes Inclusive in rating:	\$49.50 Ea.

Electrical Permit Fees

Service of 600 volts or less and over 1,000 amperes in rating:	\$99.25 Ea.
Service of over 600 volts in rating:	\$124.25 Ea.

Subpanels, Switchboard Selections and Motor Control Centers

Subpanels, switchboard sections and motor control centers of 600 volts or less and not over 399 amperes in Rating:	\$25.50 Ea.
Subpanels, switchboard sections and motor control centers of 600 volts or less and 400 to 1,000 amperes inclusive in rating:	\$49.50 Ea.
Subpanels, switchboard sections and motor control centers of 600 volts or less and over 1,000 amperes in ratings:	\$99.25 Ea.
Subpanels, switchboard sections and motor control centers of over 600 volts in rating:	\$124.25 Ea.

Pools and Spas

New in-ground swimming pool including a complete system of necessary branch circuit wiring, bonding, grounding, underwater lighting, water pumping and other similar electrical equipment directly related to the operation of the swimming pools:	\$51.25 Ea.
Alterations to swimming pools:	\$34.50 Ea.
Pools and spas, other than residential swimming pools, including therapeutic whirlpools, spas and hot tubs:	\$34.50 Ea.

Carnivals and Circuses

For electric generators and electrically driven rides:	\$24.50 Ea.
For Mechanically driven rides and walk-through attractions or displays having electric lighting:	\$7.50 Ea.
For a system of area and booth lighting:	\$7.50 Ea.

Notes:

1) *These fees apply to carnivals, circuses, or other traveling shows or exhibitions utilizing transportable-type riders, booths, displays and attractions.*

2) *For permanently installed rides, booths, displays and attractions, use the Unit Fee Schedule.*

Electrical Permit Fees

Temporary Power Service

For a temporary service pole or pedestal, including all pole or pedestal-mounted receptacle outlets and appurtenances: \$24.50 Ea.

For a temporary distribution system and temporary lighting and receptacle outlets or construction sites, decorative lights, Christmas tree sales lots, fireworks stands, etc.: \$24.50 Ea.

Miscellaneous

Trolley and plug-in type busways: \$7.50 per 100LF or fraction thereof

Electrical apparatus, conduits and conductors for which a permit is required but for which no fee is herein set forth: \$18.75 Ea.

ELECTRICAL PLAN CHECK FEES

Electrical Plan Check Fee: 70% of Electrical Permit Fee

Additional plan review after the first recheck: \$67.00/Hr.

Over-the-counter plan review: \$33.50/½ Hr.

For additional review required by changes, additions or revisions of approved or resubmitted plans or reports: \$67.00/Hr.

For additional review to determine nature and scope of work: \$67.00/Hr.

Tenant Improvement installations requiring review to verify compliance with California Energy Regulations, when not submitted with the building plans for building plan review: \$12.50/1,000 sq. ft. (\$25.00 minimum)

Note: The property owner is responsible for mending all open or expired permits on the property. All expired permits must be finalized before any new permits are issued.
