## Message Board Posting Instructions

This message board has been created to help facilitate useful dialog among the many members of the Bellflower Neighborhood Watch Program, as well as informational dialog between program members and the City's Public Safety Department.

### To Create A Screen Name:

1. Click on Register (paper icon on top of page)
2. After reading Rules and Policies, click Accept
3. Enter a Username
  - Note: It may be useful for Neighborhood Watch members to use consistent and easily identifiable names (for easy reference at a glance), such as a street name and first name (e.g. Rosecrans - David). Be aware that there is a maximum number of letters allowed for usernames.
4. Enter Password
5. Re-type Password
6. Enter the Security Code that is displayed within the box
7. Under Profile Info, fill out your real name (no other information is necessary)
8. Click Register at the bottom of the page.

**After logging in with your new screen name, you now can post messages as follows:**

### To Post a Message:

1. Click Neighborhood Watch under Public Safety heading
2. Click New Topic (right side of page) - the icon is a paper with a check mark
3. Enter a Subject
  - Note: Be sure to choose words that clearly communicate the contents of your message
4. Write your Message
5. After message is complete click post new topic
  - Note: Your message will be posted upon receiving approval from the City's Public Safety Department. "Edgy" or critical comments will not be edited, as such may help to facilitate honest dialog. However, highly personal, confidential, or obscene remarks will be deleted prior to posting.
