A. Study Session

Study Session to consider changes to the approval process related to alcohol licenses for restaurants located within the Town Center (TC) District. Staff will present various options to the Planning Commission for its consideration, including possibly amending the Bellflower Municipal Code to require an administratively-approved Conditional Use Permit rather than a Conditional Use Permit approved by the Planning Commission. No final decisions will be made at this meeting. The Planning Commission may recommend that staff prepare an ordinance to be considered by the Planning Commission (and possibly the City Council) at future hearings.
