A. Zoning Ordinance Text Amendment

Consideration and possible action to conduct a public hearing to consider a Zoning Ordinance Text Amendment; and adopt Resolution No. PC 18-21 – A Resolution recommending the City Council approve Zoning Ordinance Text Amendment Case No. ZOTA 18-05 adding a new Chapter 17.106 (Specific Plans) to the Bellflower Municipal Code (BMC) and amending the BMC to change the term “Precise Plan” to “Site Design Review.”

Pursuant to the authority and criteria of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), it has been determined that the ZOTA does not have the potential to cause significant effects on the environment and, therefore, the project is exempt from CEQA pursuant to 14 Cal. Code Regs. § 15061(b)(3). This ZOTA would not result in any development or changes to the physical environment. Following an evaluation of possible adverse impacts, it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the ZOTA will have a significant effect on the environment.

Recommendation to Planning Commission: 1) Open the public hearing; take testimonial and documentary evidence; and after considering the evidence, adopt Resolution No. PC 18-21 or 2) Alternatively, discuss and take other action related to this item.
