ORDINANCE NO. 1290

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLFLOWER AMENDING SUBSECTION 2.16.010(B) OF THE BELLFLOWER MUNICIPAL CODE TO PROVIDE A SALARY ADJUSTMENT FOR MEMBERS OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOLLOWING THE NEXT GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION

WHEREAS, the State of California Government Code Section 36516(a) establishes a salary for city councils initially based on city population, but adjustable thereafter by increases not to exceed an amount equal to five percent (5%) for each calendar year from the operative date of the last city council salary adjustment; and

WHEREAS, the City Council last adjusted its salary to the sum of One Thousand Two Hundred Seventy-two Dollars and Thirty-one Cents (\$1,272.31) per month by Ordinance No. 1245 adopted on June 24, 2013; and

WHEREAS, as permitted by State Law, the City Council desires to adjust its salary to a new amount to be effective in 2017 at such time as permitted by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLFLOWER DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Subsection 2.16.010(B) of the Bellflower Municipal Code shall be amended to read as follows:

“Compensation.

1. Each member of the Council shall receive as salary the sum of One Thousand Two Hundred Seventy-two Dollars and Thirty-one Cents (\$1,272.31) per month. The salaries prescribed herein are and shall be exclusive of any amounts payable to a member of the Council as reimbursement for actual and necessary expenses incurred by him or her in the performance of official duties for the City or benefits as approved by the City Council in accordance with the provisions of law.
2. On such date as one or more members of the City Council begin a new term of office following the next general municipal election to be held in Bellflower in March of 2017, Subsection 2.16.010(B) of the Code shall be amended to read as follows: Each member of the Council shall receive as salary the sum of One Thousand Three Hundred Ninety-nine Dollars and Fifty-four Cents (\$1,399.54) per month. The salaries prescribed herein are and shall be exclusive of any amounts payable to a member of the Council as reimbursement for actual and necessary expenses incurred by him or her in the performance of official duties for the City or benefits as approved by the City Council in accordance with the provisions of law.”

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its adoption. The City Clerk, or her duly appointed deputy, shall certify to the adoption of this Ordinance and shall cause this Ordinance to be posted as required by law.

ORDINANCE NO. 1290 HAD ITS FIRST READING ON JUNE 8, 2015, ITS SECOND READING ON JUNE 22, 2015, AND WAS DULY PASSED, APPROVED, AND ADOPTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLFLOWER AT ITS REGULAR MEETING OF JUNE 22, 2015.
