BACKGROUND

On October 12, 2015, the City Council adopted Resolution Nos. 15-82, 15-83, 15-84, and 15-85 in which it announced its intent to consider granting an oil pipeline franchise to Tesoro SoCal Pipeline Company, LCC; LT Pipeline, Inc.; Cardinal Pipeline, L.P.; and Crimson California Pipeline, L.P., respectively. The public hearings were opened on November 9, 2015, and continued to February 8, 2016. Staff believes that it would be in the City's interest to continue negotiating the franchises and therefore asks for a continuance of this matter until March 28, 2016. Consequently, Staff recommends that the City Council continue the public hearings to March 28, 2016.
