## **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

On February 16, 2016, the Public Safety Commission considered and subsequently recommended changing parking restrictions at 9945 Flower Street from one hour time restricted parking to two hour time restricted parking pursuant to Bellflower Municipal Code ("BMC") Chapter 10.04. The recommended action would implement this recommendation.

## **RECOMMENDATION TO CITY COUNCIL**

- 1) Authorize the Director of Public Works, or designee, to change from one hour time restricted parking to two hour time restricted parking fronting 9945 Flower Street; or
- 2) Alternatively, discuss and take other action related to this item.

## **FISCAL IMPACT**

The estimated cost to change the time restricted parking is \$100.00. The required funds are budgeted within the current fiscal year budget.

## **DISCUSSION**

The City recently received a request that the City change the current one hour time restricted parking fronting 9945 Flower Street to two hour time restricted parking. The proposed change is indicated on the attached aerial photograph.

On February 3, 2016, the City Engineer provided notice to area residents of this request and informed them that this matter would be brought before the Public Safety Commission at its February 16, 2016, meeting. During the February 16, 2016, Public Safety Commission Meeting, there were no speakers supporting or opposing the request; to date the City has not received any response to the notifications.

The subject area is located on the north side of Flower Street between Civic Center Drive and Bixby Avenue, directly in front of the Los Angeles County Public Library.


As background, in 2007 meetings were held with local business owners to review the on-street time based parking restrictions in place at that time, with the objective being to optimize the on-street parking supply. In response to those meetings in May 2007, the City approved maintaining the one hour time restricted parking from 7:00 AM to 6:00 PM, excluding weekends, on the north side of Flower Street from Civic Center Drive to Pacific Avenue. Recognizing that the needs of the community may change periodically, and in response to this recent request, staff recommends that the requested change be approved.


This letter is to inform you of the proposed change described below.
