## **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

This action would award a contract to Shariden Design Asphalt, Inc. (Shariden Design), to perform the work described in the plans and specification documents for the Installation of Duratherm Crosswalks on Flower Street and Bellflower Boulevard (the Project).

## **RECOMMENDATION TO CITY COUNCIL**

- 1) Award a contract to Shariden Design for the Project, and authorize the City Manager to execute a contract with Shariden Design, in a form approved by the City Attorney;  
or
- 2) Alternatively, discuss and take other action related to this item.

## **FISCAL IMPACT**

Shariden Design submitted the only responsive base bid in the amount of \$52,338.50. However, after Public Works staff evaluated the bid, it was determined the corrected base bid amount was \$52,327.50. Funds are available in Account No. 135-47050-9000 (Prop. C – Street Improvements). The Engineer's Estimate to perform the work under Specifications No. 16/17-01 was \$57,000.00 for construction and contingency.

## **DISCUSSION**

The City recently completed the Bellflower Boulevard Pedestrian Enhancements (Specifications No. 13/14-03), which included installation of Duratherm decorative thermoplastic crosswalks at the intersections of Belmont Street and Bellflower Boulevard; and Oak Street and Bellflower Boulevard. This project would provide for additional Duratherm crosswalks at the intersection of Flower Street and Bellflower Boulevard to further enhance the appearance of Bellflower Boulevard within the Town Center corridor.

## **Staff Report – Award of Contract for Specifications No. 16/17-01**

**October 24, 2016**

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On September 12, 2016, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 16-65 authorizing solicitation of bids. The City advertised Specifications No. 16/17-01 for bids in accordance with Public Contracts Code Section 20164. Shariden Design submitted the only bid at the formal bid opening on October 13, 2016.

### **BID ANALYSIS**

Shariden Design submitted a complete bid package. Staff has verified its State Contractor's License status, references, and registration with the Department of Industrial Relations. The contractor is qualified to perform the work described and has fulfilled the requirements set forth in the Project specifications package. Staff concludes Shariden Design is the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.

### **SPECIFICATIONS**

The plans and specification documents are available for public inspection at the Public Works Department Office, 9944 Flora Vista Street, Bellflower, California until completion of the project and, subsequently, as official records, will be maintained by the City Clerk's Office.

### **CEQA**

Pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Public Resources Code §§ 21000, et seq.) and CEQA Guidelines (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, §§ 15000, et seq.), the City conducted an environmental assessment. Based on the environmental assessment, the project was determined to be categorically exempt pursuant to CEQA Guidelines § 15301 (Existing Facilities).
